

TUITION DISCOUNT

Five percent will be deducted from the annual bill if the entire tuition amount is paid before August 1.

Tithing members of Hope Baptist Church receive a 25% discount on Tuition Rates.

(All other fees are *not* discounted.)

TUITION

Equal monthly tuition charges are billed for ten months, August through May.

Full tuition applies to the oldest student in a family. Decreasing tuition applies to subsequent students in the order of decreasing grade level.

PAYMENT PENALTIES

LATE FEE: This fee is assessed if any of the tuition payments have not been paid on time. There is a grace period of 10 days before the \$15.00 per family is charged.

NSF CHARGE: A \$15.00 penalty will be assessed if a check is returned due to non-sufficient funds.

DATES TO REMEMBER

FEBRUARY 1

Re-enrollment opens for present students and registration opens for new students.

MARCH 1

2010-2011 re-enrollment forms due in HCS office. (Re-enrollment fee not required now.)

MAY 1

Last tuition payment for 2009-2010 due.

JUNE 10

Re-enrollment fee discount ends

Re-enrollment fee increases from \$80 to \$95 per student.

JULY 1

Textbook Fees due.

AUGUST 1

First tuition payment for 2010-2011 due. (To receive a 5% discount, the annual tuition payment is due.)

RE-ENROLLMENT FEE \$80

\$95 after June 10

This fee applies to students presently enrolled at HCS or to those students with a sibling presently enrolled.

This fee budgets the following items:

1. Processing the enrollment of your child for the following school year.
2. Standardized testing provided for all students in Grades K-11 with the testing results given to the parents.

If \$80 payment is *not* made by June 10, this fee increases to \$95.

TEXTBOOK FEE

Kindergarten: \$110.00
Grades 1-11: \$165.00 per student
Due July

This fee applies to all students and does *not* completely cover *all* textbooks; however, this fee does help to defray the costs of the following items:

1. Classroom textbooks
2. Supplies and materials
3. Library materials (purchases & repairs)

GYM SHIRT \$8

Each student in grades 1-11 will need to purchase a school gym shirt.

STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE \$125

For students in grades 9-12 only

This fee will help to cover the costs of science lab materials and art materials. A portion of this fee will also be set aside to help cover the cost of the senior class trip.

KINDERCARE

12:00-3:00 P.M.

HCS Kindergarten students only

On school days, Kindergarten students may stay in KinderCare the other half of their day.

Routine Basis: The charge for KinderCare on a routine basis is \$75 per month (\$750 per year) and is billed along with tuition.

Per-day Basis: The charge for KinderCare on a per-day basis is \$5 per day which will be applied to your school bill.

AFTER SCHOOL CARE

3:00-5:00pm

After school care will be provided for HCS families only. The cost is \$2.00 per hour (or \$4 per day) per student. The cost will be applied to your school bill.
